During the pandemic, the Institution has adopted a continuous engagement model with the Students. Through which students are invited to online lectures and demonstrations. Initially there were connectivity issues as most of the students are in remote rural locations. Each online session was conducted for a period of 40 minutes, in which 25 minutes time devoted for lecture, 15 minutes for Question and Answers, interactions, deliberations, mentoring and others. Students were providing references to video lectures (YouTube, Swayam, NPTEL, Course-era, and other platforms) and they were encouraged to refer to the said online portals.
