IQAC convener chaired the meeting and welcomed all the participants to the meeting. The IQAC convener presented the following annual report.

1. The UG programs of Chemical, Mechanical and Information Technology were reaccredited by NBA under Tier-1 for a period of Three years 2018 – 2021. Ours is the only private institutions to get NBA accreditation under TIER-1.
2. B.Pharmacy program also got reaccredited by NBA for a period of Three years till 2020.
3. The department of CSE, school of Management and school of Pharmacy were recognized as Research Centers by JNTU Hyderabad.
4. The AGI stood in number one position in OU region for getting all seats filled since inception of the college.
5. The Institution has applied to AICTE for an increase in intake in Information Technology branch from 120 to 180 and for a new course “Artificial Intelligence” in B.Tech Computer Science and Engineering with an intake of 60 for the coming academic year 2019-20.
6. The Institution has submitted the IQAC report to NAAC for the year 2017-18.

7. Besides these achievements our students have excelled in academics and the overall pass percentage in all departments for the year 2014-18 batch is 94%.

23. The departments of the Institution had set up Center for Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence and Center for Digital Innovations and software Development where in innovative projects will be undertaken and developed coupled with latest technology.

### **NPTEL certifications by Faculty:**

Keeping track of the technological developments and to make sure the students of AGI are globally competitive by imparting knowledge in cutting edge technologies, the faculty members are encouraged to get certified in advanced subjects offered by MOOCS and NPTEL. And the encouragement made of 85 faculty members for all departments got certified in advanced courses offered by NPTEL during the academic year 2017-18.

24. During 2018-19 first semester a total of 132 faculty member from all departments got certified. And many faculties were appeared the other courses of NPTEL and results are waiting.

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## PLAN OF ACTIONS FOR THE NEXT ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

1. Motivating faculty towards advanced studies in terms of certification courses by NPTEL and other platforms through Teaching and Learning Centre(TLC) of AGI : Many faculty have got prestigious NPTEL certifications from leading IITS in various subjects, faculty were are also trained through various FDPs, Technical training programs organized by TASK and other leading industries. To share this knowledge among all staff members and students it is decided to strengthen the TLC in the next year. All heads of the departments are given directions in this regard.
2. To create successful conduction of International conferences at AGI: To form various committees to organize the two international conferences and other conferences that are being conducted in the next academic year at the Institute i) Springer International Conference on “Intelligent Computing and Smart Communication Technologies” (ICSCT), at Anurag Group of Institutions, Hyderabad, 26-27, July 2019. By Department of ECE and EEE ii) 1<sup>st</sup> International Conference on “Advances in Computational Intelligence and Informatics” (ICACII-2019) from December 20-21-2019 with Springer by department of CSE ii) Seventh International conference on Transformations in Engineering Education (ICTIEE-2020), at AGI under Indo Universal Collaboration for Engineering Education (IUCEE) iii) AHCSSC -20 (All Hyderabad Section Computer Society Student Congress), to see that the conferences provides a value to the society.
3. To strengthen the staff and students to participate in outreach and sports activities. The IQAC appreciated the efforts that are kept by NSS and Physical director’s team, however asked to strengthen these activities further to create more awareness. All heads of the departments are advised to coordinate and cooperate with NSS and PDS to enrich these activities.

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4. To sign more number of MOUS with Tier-1 industries, to increase interaction between industry and academia, to bring placements, industry oriented consultancies, to organize training program for students and staff under Institute Industry Interaction (III) cell. The coordinator III cell is advised to work along with TLC, placement cell and R&D cell to initiate the above activities. The TLC, Placement cell and R&D cell are advised to cooperate with III cell.
5. Quality and Strategic Roadmap to promote the AGI to the University level. The IQAC requested the Director AGI to formulate a committee to look in to this aspect. To apply for NBA Reaccreditations. To start a new UG Engineering Course in emerging area: “Artificial Intelligence” with an intake of 60 students from next academic year. The Chairman BOS of CSE & IT and the Dean CSE& IT, is asked to formulate the course structure and contents by going through the course structure of various leading universities and get it approved.
6. Research and Development Policy 1: To encourage the staff to submit various projects, FDPs etc. under various funding agencies in the next academic year. All doctorates and senior faculties are being instructed to submit at least one proposal.
7. Research and Development Policy 2: To encourage research among the young faculty, five faculties without Ph.D will be assigned to each doctorate for guidance. The progress should be monitored by R&D cell and should be informed to director for further action. The HODS are instructed to allocate five faculties based on their interest to doctorate faculty.
8. Collect and compile feedback responses from students, parents and other stakeholders: The Heads of the departments and various cells in chargers are instructed to collect in time and analyze the same for the improvement of academic and administrative activities of AGI.



9. Strengthening the Mentoring activities: It is decided to give very high priority to the mentoring system. And mentors are advised to have continuous touch and monitor their mentees,. The heads the departments are advised to monitor this process.
10. Building career paths and enhancing competencies of students: it is decided to give adequate training to the students to bridge the gap between industry and academia and to enhance further placements. The members approved the action plan of the next academic year.

### **Remarks of the Director of AGI and chairperson of IQACs**

The Director AGI and chairperson of IQAC, Dr. K.S. Rao, appreciated the role of IQAC in developing a systematic, consistent and catalytic action for improving the academic and administrative performance of the institution during the academic year 2018-2019.
